

THE TEACHING ASSISTANT PROGRAM IN FRANCE

Program Dates

October 1, 2019 - April 30, 2020

Eligibility

Must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident. Must be between 20 and 35 years old and have completed at least 3 years of higher education by October 1, 2019. Must be a native speaker of English with at least intermediate level (B1) proficiency in French. See website for additional criteria.

Benefits

Salary of €790 net per month. Health insurance provided. Housing not provided (host schools and administrators offer advice and support when possible).

Job Duties

Assistant teaches English classes for a total of 12 classroom hours per week in up to 3 schools. Assistant serves as a resource person in conversation groups, organizes activities and tutorials for small groups, facilitates language clubs, and/or works alongside the teacher with the entire class present. Positions in primary and secondary schools across France, and in Réunion, Martinique, Guadeloupe, and French Guiana. 1,200 positions available for 2019-2020.
