## WHAT IS THE FOUR-YEAR B.A. + M.A. PROGRAM?

This program allows students to save both time and money by earning their B.A. and M.A. degrees in four years. Highly motivated and well-prepared students can take advantage of this program in the following four majors: Classics, French, German, and Spanish.

## WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE IN THE FOUR-YEAR B.A. + M.A. PROGRAM?

- B.A. and M.A. degrees will be awarded after successful completion of all requirements at the end of the fourth year.
- Faculty advisor will provide guidance through the entire program.
- Streamlined educational pathway to attain both B.A. and M.A. degrees
- Use undergraduate scholarships even for graduate courses
- Optional Education Abroad programs
- Earn departmental honors by maintaining a 3.5 GPA



# SO HOW DOES IT WORK?

- 1 BRING AP CREDITS**  
 Enter your 1st year at UK with at least 15 AP/dual credits.  
 Test into 300+ level language courses.
- 2 ENROLL IN UNDERGRADUATE COURSES**  
 Take required undergraduate courses in consultation with your faculty advisor.
- 3 APPLY FOR UNIVERSITY SCHOLARS PROGRAM AT THE END OF YOUR SOPHOMORE YEAR**  
 Admission to the graduate program is guaranteed if you maintain a good academic standing.
- 4 ENROLL IN GRADUATE COURSES**  
 Up to 12 hours of graduate courses will count as dual credit toward both undergraduate and graduate requirements.
- 5 GRADUATE WITH BOTH B.A. + M.A. DEGREES IN FOUR YEARS!**

Students in the combined BA/MA program are eligible for MCL Scholars, and will graduate with honors in the major, if they:

- 1) Have a high school GPA of 3.5 or higher upon entry to UK;
- 2) Maintain an overall GPA of 3.5 or higher while at UK. If the overall GPA falls below 3.5, the student will be removed from the MCL Scholars Program;
- 3) Participate in an Education Abroad Study Program or International Internship;
- 4) Complete the MA exam successfully.
